Summer School

This six week remedial session helps children with specific learning disabilities develop to their full academic potential by providing individual and small group instruction. In addition to a **daily 1:1 tutorial**, an individualized curriculum is offered to each child, **ages 6 – 15**, in the areas of language arts, math, auditory-visual training and motor skills.

Ready, Set...Read!

This course is designed for **kindergarten** and **first grade** students who are not reading with ease. The class is based on current reading research. Instruction will include phonemic awareness and listening skills. Manuscript handwriting practice will be incorporated into each daily lesson. Students who attend this course will learn how to read and spell one-syllable words. Techniques that differ from traditional reading instruction will be utilized.

Keyboarding

This class teaches the fundamentals of touch-typing. Creative, fast-paced drills, games and other activities are used to promote the learning of key location and finger placement. Emphasis is based on individual learning and pacing. This class is for students **ages 10 - 16**.
